

LESSON PLAN: Learn the Arabic alphabet	
Class: 1	Version: 1.0 04/09
Time required: 30-40 minutes over 2-3 weeks	
Learning Objectives:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognise the shape and form of Arabic alphabet letters • Learn how to pronounce each of the letters • Be able to recite the whole alphabet 	
Resources Required:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coloured paper & card • Arabic Alphabet Chart • Safety scissors • Glue • Glitter etc <p><i>(For any out of stock items please place an order through MAEC Admin)</i></p>	
Lesson Outline:	
<p>Looking at the Arabic Alphabet chart, ask each child to select a letter of his/her choice. Then help the child to draw an outline of that letter onto a small piece of card.</p> <p>Ask each child to decorate the letter according to his/her own creative taste!</p> <p>Create a collection of Arabic letters that will later be used for revising the Arabic alphabet. Ensure you have all the letters. It's probably best to do this activity over 2 or 3 lessons rather than all in one go.</p> <p>Once all the letters have been created, why not cut them out and stick them onto a large piece of coloured paper to create our very own Arabic Alphabet chart.</p>	
Assessment:	
<p>After completion of the activity (i.e. once all letters have been created) ask every child to name the different letters that they have created. Also test whether the child can read the entire alphabet by heart.</p>	
Evaluation:	
<p>After the lesson please write on the reverse of this plan what went well and what didn't go so well. Make a note of any improvements that could be made to this lesson plan.</p>
